

UC SAN DIEGO BIKE CAGE ACCESS USER AGREEMENT

Eligibility: Bike Cage Access is available to all current UC San Diego faculty, staff or students with valid UC San Diego ID card.

Locations: Access valid at Gilman Bike Cage or Osler Bike Cage locations (user must choose one).

Cost: \$0.00 - Free access for current Pedal Club Members (valid during active Pedal Club participation).

\$15.00 - Non Pedal Club members (valid during terms detailed below, no refunds or replacements).

Requirements: VBC user must download virtual bicycle cage app (Brivo On-Air) to their smart phone device. Further instructions will be provided by email during activation process.

Terms and Conditions:

UC San Diego bicycle cages are for the purpose of daily short term bicycle parking. Long term storage is not permitted. Bicycles left for more than 30-days may be tagged and impounded by UCPD. Park your bicycle at your own risk.

User acknowledges UC San Diego accepts no responsibility and provides no bailment for user's property. Bicycle theft or damage of personal property should be reported to UCPD at 858-534-HELP (4357).

Bike cage parking is available on a first come, first serve basis. If there are no available spaces left, you may not use the bike cage facility at that time. Double parked bicycles may be impounded and user access will be revoked indefinitely.

The bike cage may only be used for bicycle parking. All bicycles must be registered with current bicycle license stickers and properly parked/locked in stalls. Unregistered bicycles may be impounded by UCPD.

No scooters, mopeds, skateboards, motorcycles, or personal items. Please do not leave locks, cables or shoes/clothing etc., locked to the cage or bicycle rack. Unattended unlocked bicycles, locks, cables and personal items may be cut and removed by UC San Diego PD.

User agrees to help keep the bike area clean, ensure that the door is locked, and report any damages to the cage or lock system immediately.

For your safety and the safety of others, there are no guests allowed in the bike cages. One person per entry, and only one bicycle may be stored per user.

GBC access cards are non-transferrable, non-refundable and non-replaceable.

UC San Diego reserves the right to deactivate access after 90-days of inactivity without refund.

Lost/Stolen proximity cards must be reported to the Commute Solutions office within 24-hours.
