

# Triton Commuter Club Monthly and Special Challenge Day Incentive Drawings, 2020-21 Academic Year

#### Official Rules

## 1. Entry Period.

- a. Entries for monthly drawings are accepted through the last day of each calendar month.
- b. Transportation Services has also declared five Special Challenge Days where participants may earn entries in a special drawing for by participating in the challenge and logging the trip by the end of that day.
  - i. Clean Air Day, October 7, 2020
  - ii. Free Ride Day, November 3, 2020
  - iii. Earth Day, April 22, 2021
  - iv. Bike to Work and School Day, May 21, 2021
  - v. Car-Free Day, September 22, 2021

## 2. Eligibility.

- a. UC San Diego affiliates (students, faculty, and staff only) that do not have an annual or "consecutive days" parking permit are the only persons eligible to participate in the Triton Commuter Club.
- b. The Drawings covered by these Official Rules are only open to Triton Commuter Club members that do not elect to earn discounted parking as their incentive.
- c. By participating, entrants agree to comply with these official rules, the sponsor's interpretation of them and the decisions made by the sponsor in matters relating to the contest.
- d. By participating, entrants release and hold harmless the sponsor against any and all claims, injury or damage arising out of or relating to participation in this contest and/or use or misuse or redemption of a prize.

## 3. To Enter.

a. Entrants will automatically be entered when they log trips either made or avoided using the Triton Commuter Club's trip logging survey sent to Triton Commuter Club members each month.

- b. Entrants earn one entry per day in which they log all commute trips as avoided or made in a mode other than driving alone, up to a maximum of five entries per calendar week.
- c. NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT REQUIRED FOR ENTRY.
- d. Entries received during the entry period are eligible for that period's drawing.
- e. Each entry earned on a Special Challenge Day represents an entry in the drawing for that challenge day in addition to the drawings for that month and that quarter.
  - i. Clean Air Day, October 7, 2020 To enter, log a non-drive alone trip or trip avoided by remote work/learning or a compressed work week using the Triton Commuter Club's trip logging survey
  - ii. Free Ride Day, November 3, 2020 To enter, log a trip on public transit (bus, rail, or campus shuttle) using the Triton Commuter Club's trip logging survey
  - iii. Earth Day, April 22, 2021 To enter, log a non-drive alone trip or trip avoided by remote work/learning or a compressed work week using the Triton Commuter Club's trip logging survey
  - iv. Bike to Work and School Day, May 21, 2021 To enter, log a trip by bicycle using the Triton Commuter Club's trip logging survey
  - v. Car-Free Day, September 22, 2021 To enter, log a non-drive alone trip or trip avoided by remote work/learning or a compressed work week using the Triton Commuter Club's trip logging survey
- f. To enter the drawing without using the Triton Commuter Club's trip logging survey, send a letter containing your full name, UC San Diego affiliation details, the month, or special challenge day drawing you wish to enter, and email address to: Triton Commuter Club, 9500 Gilman Drive #0011, La Jolla, CA 92093-0011. Letters must be received by the last day of the month in order to be considered for that month's drawing. Letters must be received by the last day of the quarter to be considered for that quarter's drawing. Letters must be received on the special challenge day to be eligible for that day's drawing. Entries for each drawing are limited to five entries per person per week and one entry per person per day. In the event that multiple entries from the same individual are received for the same drawing on the same day, only the first entry will be valid.
- 4. **Prize Winners Selection/Notification.** Winners will be randomly selected from among all valid entries received for each monthly and Special Challenge Day drawing. Winners will be notified by email and prizes may be fulfilled electronically or by US mail. Sponsor reserves the right to select additional winners for unclaimed prizes.
- 5. Prizes.

The odds of winning a prize depend upon the total number of participants, which is likely to vary by month, quarter, or special challenge day.

- a. <u>Monthly Drawing</u>: Twenty winners, each month, will be awarded a gift card valued at \$50.
- b. <u>Special Challenge Day Drawings</u>: Ten total Special Challenge Day winners will be awarded a gift card valued at \$25 each.

## 6. **General Terms.**

- a. Contest is void where prohibited by law.
- b. Sponsor reserves the right in its sole discretion to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the contest.
- c. Entrants agree to indemnify and hold harmless the sponsor from any and all liability resulting or arising from the contest, to release all rights to bring any claim, action or proceeding against the sponsor, and hereby acknowledge that the sponsor has neither made nor is in any manner responsible or liable for any warranty, representation or guarantee, express or implied, in fact or in law, relative to the prize or prizes.
- d. Entrants agree that their name may be shared publicly in an announcement of winners.
- e. Taxes due on winnings are the sole responsibility of the winners
- 7. **Sponsor.** Contest is sponsored by UC San Diego Transportation Services as part of the campaign to reduce environmental, traffic, and parking impacts from commute travel.
- 8. **Disputes.** The exclusive jurisdiction and venue for any disputes arising from this contest will be the courts located in San Diego County, California. In all cases, sponsor's liability shall be limited to the value of one prize (i.e., a \$50 gift card).
